As the Principal, and on behalf of the faculty, staff, administration, and fellow students it is with great pleasure that I welcome you.

The Pak Red Crescent Medical College which was established seven years ago, has passed the stage of infancy and now it has grown-up to a level where it can be compared to any good private medical college in Punjab. The two newly build academic blocks have all the teaching facilities including five lecture theatres, seven state-of-the-art laboratories, five demonstration rooms, a fully equipped dissection hall, four museums, a skill lab, two libraries, a computer lab and common rooms. In addition, we have separate boys' and girls' hostels, a cafeteria and an auditorium, all in the same premises.

I strongly believe that the most important single factor which differentiate a good academic institution from the ordinary is its faculty and we at Pak Red Crescent Medical College feel proud to have highly qualified and experienced faculty in all the subjects. We have recently added 48 new faculty members including 12 Professors who have extensive teaching experience in some of the highly reputed medical colleges in Pakistan as well as abroad.

The attached teaching hospital which is situated in the same premises, has 500 beds, five fully equipped operating theatres and all the diagnostic facilities including X-Rays, ultrasound, C.T Scan and a state-of-the-art clinical laboratory. The hospital is situated in a thickly populated area where we get lot of poor patients from the surrounding villages. We have very busy OPD and Accident & Emergency departments since we provide free treatment to all the poor and needy patients. This facility is not only a blessing for an underprivileged population of southern Lahore and district Kasur but at the same time it provides ample opportunities to our students to develop their clinical skills and hands on training, the opportunity which is although available in the Government sector teaching hospitals but is almost nonexistent in most of the hospitals attached to private medical colleges.

We believe in strict discipline; therefore, we expect our students to abide by all the rules and regulations of our college, failing that would make them liable to have strict disciplinary action taken against them which includes expulsion from the college. In addition, we expect our students to be regular in their classes, minimum attendance required being 80% and pass all their class as well as ward tests. Any student who fail to meet these two criteria, will be debarred to appear in the professional examination of the UHS.

Our mission as an institution is to teach with creativity and dedication, to heal with quality and compassion, and to inspire discovery and innovation with integrity and resolve. I along with my faculty are therefore, committed not only to impart the best possible knowledge to our students but at the same time we spend a significant time and energy in their personality building through our well-organized mentorship program and healthy co-curricular activities. B asic Medical Sciences



BASIC DEPARTMENTS

1. Department of Anatomy

This department is well equipped with dissection hall with cadaver, Torso for anatomy dissection, spacious histology laboratory that contains multi head, slide projecting and binocular microscopes, state of the art anatomy museum and human body specimen and models with projectors. In addition the teaching material includes torso and human skeleton which are available in the department. There is facility to provide bones to students as per the need for teaching purpose. This department has adequate faculty and staff to teach the students. Department is headed by senior experienced Professor.



2. Department of Physiology

Department has all faculty members headed by senior Professor. This department is well equipped with high quality equipment that remains under the eyes of faculty and maintained by technical staff.



3. Department of Biochemistry



The departmental laboratory along with its preparation rooms equipped with essential equipment to perform practical under the supervision of faculty and technical staff.



4. Department of Pathology

Department of Pathology headed by Professor Dr. Jawaid Subzwari (MBBS M. Phil Chemical Pathology) having experience in teaching to the subject for under graduate and postgraduate students over twenty years. He is competent to manage clinical laboratory in a hospital setting. He also has reasonable experience in medical research and medical education.

Pathology department fulfils both teaching and clinical diagnostic responsibilities, under the supervision of faculty and technical staff. This department is equipped with Pathology museum, microscopic slides, multi head microscope and binocular microscopes for teaching purpose.

Pathology department includes:

1. Histopathology
2. Microbiology
3. Chemical Pathology

4. Hematology and Blood bank Pathology department in hospital is equipped with state of art instruments (automated) for each section separately that perform different tests under quality

control program for patient samples reaching to the lab from every corner of hospital. Faculty comprises of two Professors, two Associate Professors, four Assistant Professor and demonstrators.



5. Department of Forensic Medicine

Forensic Medicine Department is supervised by qualified and experienced faculty. This department has a well-equipped laboratory and its museum house, with a number of models, specimens, mountings, charts, skeleton and x-rays, highlighting various medical aspects essential for medical learning to keep the abreast with advanced teaching in the subject.



6. Department of Pharmacology

It is running by qualified and experienced faculty and a well-equipped pharmacology laboratory that is used for practicals of students. The department is headed by an experienced PhD Professor.



7. Department of Community Medicine

The department is engaged in imparting knowledge and skills to the medical students regarding the preventive, social, public and community health. This enables them to learn, apply and provide preventive, curative and rehabilitated services to the ailing community under the qualified and experience faculty. Department comprises of two senior Professors with PhD qualification.

The departmental museum has requisite models and specimens for student learning and its laboratory is well equipped for students practical demonstration supervision of experienced faculty and health professionals. The regular field visits notified in the time table which is an important feature of the subject curriculum. Students are coached for research work by assigning different projects.



8. Department of Behavior Sciences

The department is headed by experienced faculty. Regular classes are held in third year MBBS. Clinical training is also given in medical OPD for psychosocial aspects in behavioral sciences. Counseling and psycho educational sessions are conducted for students and patients as per need by qualified clinical psychiatrist.

9. Department of Medical Education

This is independent department headed by experienced M/E qualified Assistant Professor, has been established in line with PM&DC and to address the demands of offering medical education and training in rapidly changing health care system. The department primarily focuses on activities that promote and support the development and functions of faculty as educators and students as learner. A mentor program has been established under the supervision of this department.

CLINICAL DEPARTMENTS

1. Department of Medicine

The department of Medicine is a highly specialized unit which educates the students about expert diagnosis and compassionate management of human illness based on biochemical, radiological, behavioral aspect of diseases. Students are taught information acquisition through history taking, Physical examination, laboratory evaluation under the guidelines of faculty and unit registrar.

In this hospital department of medicine is catering cases of pulmonology, Urology, cardiology, dermatology and Psychiatry are separate intities.

The department of Medicine has 6 day a week OPD, two consultant clinic, male and female general ward medical ICU and tutorial rooms for students.



2. Department of Surgery


The field of surgery is an integral part to teach the medical students as well as to provide the excellent health care facilities to the patient. This department is headed by Professor Dr. Abid Hussain who is a qualified and experienced surgeon and performing his job with dedication in this area since 1998. Under his supervision and with the assistance of the faculty members, training of the students always remained par excellence.

Clinical training in this department starts from third year and continuous up to final year. Here not only general surgery is performed which remains the mother of all the fields but also surgical producers related with trauma and emergency and elective procedures of an extensive range which include laparoscopic surgery.

It has six days a week OPD, two consultant clinic, male female general ward, operations theaters with pre and postoperative facilities, surgical ICU, tutorial room for student teaching and round the clock emergency services.

- c) To make significant advances in scientific knowledge and clinical practice through basic and clinical research.



3. Department of Orthopedics

Full fledged orthopedic department is functioning in Pakistan Red crescent hospital headed by foreign qualified orthopedic surgeon Professor Dr. Waqar Saleem Farooqi he is CEO/Principal also. There are separate male and female orthopedic wards having strength of 40 beds. The operation theater is equipped with state of art equipment for required surgical procedures including application of implants.



4. Department of Pediatric Medicine

The department headed by Prof. Dr. Tallat Seyal is providing care to newborn, infants, child and adolescence cases. Being a strong liaison between Pediatric department and department of Obstetrics there has been a significant decrease in prenatal morbidity and mortality. Department (OPD and Indoor) are cared by experienced and qualified doctors along with trained staff nurses. The hospital frequently establishes and manages free child camps in surrounding areas especially for gastroenteritis, bronchial asthma and vaccination etc. There is 24 hour emergency service for pediatric and neonatal patients in addition to outpatient. This department is equipped with incubators in nursery for critical patients.



5. Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics

Well qualified and teaching faculty manages the under graduate curriculum and training under the supervision of Professor Dr. Kishwer Naheed (MBBS, MCPS, FCPS) to head the department. She has a teaching experience of over seven year and also many publications to her credit. She has also attended many workshops and seminars related to the specialty. Another Prof. Dr. Sara Ejaz is providing her highly skilled services also.

It is a well established department having inpatient and outpatient facilities, operation theaters with pre and post operative areas and labour room with ultrasound and CTG facility. The department has all the equipment to perform all kinds of minor and major Surgeries and has the full capacity of advanced and complicated Gynecological operations.

This department in near future will be recognized by CPSP for post graduate training program and many PG- trainees will be supervised.

6. Department of Ophthalmology

Department of Ophthalmology is well equipped to perform routine eye operations and procedures including cataract surgery with Phako and IOL. The department has 6 days a week OPD and consultation. The clinical department is supported by well experienced and qualified faculty to train the undergraduate students. This department is well equipped with latest machinery and Prof of Ophthalmology is competent and hardworking.




7. Department of ENT

Ear, Nose and throat diseases (form the bulk of medical diseases all over the world) and the patients related this area of dieses are mostly attended in OPD, in our hospital which runs 6 days a week under the experienced doctors. The emphasis of the department is on the learning of ENT through observing the patients in OPD, attend Operation Theater and go through clinico-pathological conferences where students participate by case presentation. The department also organizes seminars and tutorials on common ENT problems. The department is well equipped to perform all kind of routine and emergency surgical procedures in the department. The department is working under the supervision of Professor Dr. Tariq Enwar who has vast specialty experience.



9. Department of Radiology

Diagnostic wing of any hospital is considered more vital in any clinical setting because it facilitates surgeons, Physicians and Gynecologist to take the appropriate decision regarding management of the patients. The department of radiology is equipped with state of the art modern diagnostic equipment such as X-rays, USG, and colour Doppler ultrasound. Daily approximately 100 patients are visiting this department. Other facilities in clinical u d e conducting important procedures such as IVP, HSG and ultrasound guided biopsy for exact diagnosis of any disease. In near future facility of CR system /CT scan and MRI has been planned for the department. CT Scan and Mammography installment is major achievement of this department.



10. Department of Accident & Emergency

It is a vital and essential part of teaching hospital. Emergency cater all the road side accident because teaching hospital is lying on main Multan Road. There are excellent emergency services round the clock 24/7. There is minor operation theater and special care beds with all necessary equipment with Radiology and Pathology lab backup. Experienced Assistant Professor/Surgeon is HOD and EMOs of all specialties are available perpetually. Pharmacy remains open 24/7 inaugurated by worthy chairman.



10. Department of Anesthesia

It is back bone of all type of surgeries and intensive care unit & pre surgery evaluation of patients. This department is headed by experienced highly qualified teachers and having competent staff.



11. Department of Dermatology

This department is headed by Professor of Dermatology. There are lot of patients in this rural, poor and unhygienic area. Latest equipment are available with laser and cautery. This department also covers venereal diseases



12. Department of Urology

This department covers the kidney diseases and there is plan to established dialysis center in teaching hospital.

13. Department of Gastroenterology

This is well established unit headed by the Assistant Professor to cater the gastroenterology diseases.



13. Department of Pulmonology

This department is covering the respiratory diseases. There are lot of industries in this area and chest diseases are common among workers of factories around. It is headed by Assistant Professor and back with Radiology & Pathology lab. Free TB clinic is also working under this

FACILITIES

1. HOSTEL FACILITIES:



The medical college has appropriate number of furnished rooms to provide hostel accommodation to the students, intending to reside in hostel. Separate hostel accommodation is built for boys and girls. Mess facilities will also be provided in the hostel for boys and girls separately.



Administrative structure of Hostels

There is a chief warden and warden of hostels. Students management committee looks after hostel messes in consultation with chief warden/ warden. There is homely secured environment in hostels. Chief warden is professor or assistant professor, active trained guards and honest servant are provided.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

- The student will abide by rules promulgated by the Principal from time to time.
- Students are not allowed to keep fire arms or narcotics in their room in hostels.
- Unauthorized students will not be allowed to live in the hostels. If such case is reported strict disciplinary action will be taken against the students who will accommodate unauthorized guests.
- No female guest is allowed in the boys hostels and no male guest is allowed in the girls hostels under any circumstances.
- Defaulters will not be allowed to live in the hostel.
- Any student guilty of misconduct and violation of hostel rules will be expelled from the hostel by the Principal on advice of the warden of hostels.
- The students will be responsible for paying extra dues for additional use of electric appliances like air conditioner, refrigerators, microwave ovens, iron etc.

Mess Management System

- The Warden has Constituted separate mess committees and prefects to supervise the messes of the hostels each for Boys and Girls.
- The Warden ensures appropriate excellent standard of cleanliness & quality of food in the messes.
- Proper record of meals taken by the student and payments made by them is maintained by a hostel clerk.

2. LIBRARY SERVICES

The college has a well-established central air conditioned library. It has all essential medical books needed for medical students and faculty. A general section of the library has books on religion, Pak Study, helping the students in personality development. The library has educational CDs & DVDs and a portal of digital library equipped with ten computer workstations with facility of internet services. A well trained librarian along with other staff has been appointed in the library to facilities the students and faculty members. The working hours of the library are from 8:30 am to 12:00 mid night. The students should utilize the library facilities as all the recent editions of important books are available. Moreover, important scientific journals are also available in the library for students and faculty.



3. MEDICAL SUPPORT

It is provided for students and faculty who can avail medical facilities at Pak Red Crescent Medical & Teaching Hospital, Dina Nath free of cost.

4. SKILL LAB

Unique and distinguished feature of this college is state of art skills lab for students. It is mandatory for all 3rd year, 4th year, and final year MBBS students when they are exposed in clinical wards for training related with clinical subjects. In this skill lab there is separate section for anesthesia, Surgery, Medicine, Gynecology and Pathology. This lab is well equipped in advanced audio visual system for student practical demonstration before hands-on Patients. Being equipment with finest and latest equipment's. Skill lab is a major source of motivation for 3rd MBBS students. Dr. Shahzad Imran (SR Anesthesia) is incharge of the skill lab.



5. CAFETERIA

5. SECURITY SYSTEM


A well developed security system is applied with walk through gate and 24 hours security guards surrounding the campus.

Admission Policy

- There will be Central Induction by the University of Health Sciences Lahore and only those students will be admitted, which shall be directed by the university.

Mode of Application For The Admission

After advertisement in the newspaper by University of Health Sciences eligible students will apply online to the university and selection list of candidates will be forwarded by the university for further admission.

Subsequent fees: As per the on-going schedules most examination are held in the month of Sep/Oct of each year with the senior classes (4th & 5th year) spilling in to Nov/Dec. The students are directed all fees to be cleared before the send-up exams and fixed time frame is by 31 July each year, otherwise admission form of the candidate will not be sent to the university.

Note: Fee structure may be revised annually and will rise according to PM&DC/PMC.

Refund Policy

College follows the refund policy as prescribed by PM&DC/PMC for the students admitted in that session for refund of tuition dues to the students.



Late fee fine policy

- Parents are requested to pay college dues before the notified due date otherwise fine will be imposed as per following schedule.
- Delayed payment of college dues after the due date carries a fine of Rs. 50 per day for the first three days and Rs 100 per day for next 30 days.
- In case of nonpayment of fee and charges after 60 days of due date without valid reason the name of student will be struck off from college roll and readmission on college roll only be after readmission fee Rs.25000/ only
- However the full admission fees of Rs 50,000/- Will be charged in the case of nonpayment of fee 90 days after the due date.
- Students will not be allowed to appear in university exam unless all dues are cleared prior to the university exam.



Medical Fitness Requirement At The Time of Admission

- The candidates who have been selected provisionally shall be examined medically by a medical board to be constituted by Principal of Pak Red Crescent Medical & Dental College
- The selected candidate must produce certificate of vaccination against following diseases
- Inoculation against typhoid fever within preceding twelve month
- Fully vaccinated against tetanus
- Fully vaccinated against Hepatitis “B”
- Foreign students will have to produce a certificate of their HIV status
- All candidates must produce certificate stating his/her serological status of HCV & HBV.
- The list of selected applicants for admission in PRCMDC will be notified after medical fitness examination and having passed interview of PRCMDC Lahore.
- The selected applicants will produce the following original documents at the time of admission:
 - Matric, F.Sc (Pre-Medical) or equivalent certificate from (HEC) or (IBCC).
 - Character Certificate
 - Domicile Certificate

Re-Admission of Students

If any of the students, who left the studies from the college or has been expelled from the college on disciplinary ground applies for re-admission in the college, his/her application will be referred by Principal to the re-admission Committee which will follow a prescribed methodology and submit its recommendations to Principal within 15 days. The Principal may agree or may not agree with the recommendations of the re-admission committee. The decision of the re-admission Committee or Principal will not be challengeable in the court of law. The student if readmitted will pay the pending dues against him/her and re-admission fee.



EXAMINATIONS

- The qualification criteria for continuation of medical education as enshrined in PM&DC/PMC regulations and university of Health Sciences statutes will be followed.
- PRCM&DC will follow a sound system of formative and summative assessments duly supported by regular feedback.
- Formative assessment: Periodic internal assessment of students will be carried out by regular home tests. Schedule of these tests will be notified by the Principal from time to time. Result of the home tests will be displayed on the notice board for the information of the students.
- Summative assessment: The professional examination of University of Health Sciences will be held on a schedule specified by the university of Health sciences Lahore.
- Criteria for eligibility to appear in university examination, as laid by the University of Health sciences, Lahore will be strictly followed.
- Innovative modern tools of assessment (SEQs, MCQs, OSPE, DOPS, Mini –CEX and structured Viva) will be adopted in the medical college to make the internal assessments fair, valid and reliable.
- Before each university examination, there will be send- up examination. Any student who fails to pass the send-up examination will not be eligible to sit in the University Examination.
- Another essential requirement for eligibility to sit in the university examination will be at least 75% attendance of the student in all the theory & practical classes held during the teaching session in every subject concerned. Detained students should also have to complete 80% attendance their previous attendance will not be considered.
- The students must have cleared all college, hostel, Canteen, the University examination fee and fine imposed upon him before his/her name is sent to University as an eligible student.



DISCIPLINE

In order to keep an atmosphere of security and calmness in the medical college, hostel and teaching hospitals, following disciplinary rules will be enforced.

Any type of ragging with new coming class (1st year MBBS) is strictly prohibited both in college and hostels premises. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against the defaulters and maximum punishment may be expulsion from college.

- A disciplinary committee (DC) shall be constituted by the principal. The committee shall be comprised of one or more Professors and one or more Associate Professor/Assistant Professors. The Principal shall have the power to re-constitute disciplinary committee from time to time.
- Any major act of indiscipline committed by a student/group of students will be brought to the notice of the Principal and referred to the chairman of the disciplinary committee. The DC will conduct a detailed inquiry into the matter and submits its findings and recommendations to the Principal.
- The principal will implement the recommendations of the DC. However, the Principal shall have the power to decrease or amend the punishment recommended by the DC.
 - The various forms of the punishment which may be awarded are as follows:
 - A written warning to be careful in future.
 - Suspension from the college roll for a period of 14 days.
 - Imposition of the fine up to Rs. 10,000/- depending on the gravity of the indiscipline.
 - Expulsion from the hostels.
 - Expulsion from the college for six months to two years.
- Rustication and permanently striking off the college roll and never to be admitted in the college.
- The cases of infliction of injuries, major theft, possession of weapons/firearms, area or homicide, will be referred to the laws enforcing agencies for proceedings according to the law of the country.
- Minor acts of breach of discipline will be referred to a vigilance committee for probing and deciding punishments. The vigilance committee will also supervise the students with regard to their behavior in the college, observance of the dress code and bunking of class, etc. The vigilance committee shall consist of at least one Professor and one or more Associate/Assistant professors.



- Students are required to observe the following rules during the course of their studies at the college.
 - Students will not be allowed to keep any guest in the college hostel without the prior written approval of the competent authority i.e. warden hostels and no male can keep in the girl's hostel under any circumstances whatsoever.
 - Students are forbidden from indulging in any political, partisan or sectarian activity in the college and its affiliated hospitals, or in the hostels.
 - Unauthorized absence from the class will be considered as serious breach of conduct. In case of illness, students will be required to submit a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
 - Students commuting by the college transport are required to maintain discipline in the vehicles while commuting to and from the college. Any damage caused to the transport by the students will result in severe action, including but not limiting to paying the cost of necessary repairs.
 - Any damage caused to the property of the college or affiliated teaching hospital and hostels which includes laboratory equipment, furniture & fixture, canteen, library books, plantation etc. or any other thing in the premises of PRCM&DC, will be considered as serious act of discipline and students will be asked to compensate as determined by appropriate authority.
 - It is mandatory for all students to remain in college premises during working hours. Anybody venturing out in the surrounding areas will do so at his/her own risk and will be liable for necessary disciplinary action.
 - All students must display their college ID cards in college premises.
 - Chalking is strictly prohibited and necessary action will be taken against those students who are found indulged chalking the premises.
 - Smoking is strictly prohibited in college, hostel premises and affiliated hostels.
 - Student must follow the dress code of the college, as notified by the college administrations from time to time, violation of college dress code will result in disciplinary action against the defaulters.
 - The students found misbehaving with any faculty member or administrative staff will be dealt with as per disciplinary rules.
- Note:** The college authority reserves the right to amend, change or modify these rules any time without giving any notice.



CODE OF CONDUCT

- Cheating , social misconduct or infractions of college rules, stealing ,willful destruction of college property , use of physical force against other students/ patients/ staff, use of drugs, possession/use of weapons, inciting disturbance / strikes , repeated absence without permission from classes /clinics/ Laboratories will be referred to the college disciplinary committee which after investigation will recommend appropriate action. It may result even in removal of students' name from the college roll.
- Students are expected to attend all classes, demonstrations, Practical and clinical teaching sessions. Attendance and academic record of every student are properly maintained by the respective teaching departments and student's affair section of college secretariat and a copy of each trimester is posted to parents / guardian for their information and feedback from them.
- It is mandatory for the students, as per college and university of health sciences rules to have at least 80% of the total class attendances to be eligible to appear in university professional examinations. The admission forms of those students whose class attendances are less than 80% of the total are not forwarded.
- Students should not expect grant of leave of absence during working days expect in case of an emergency.
- All leave applications must be addressed to principal in writing for sanction.
- Students are expected to take care of college / hospital property and any damage caused by them will be charged in full to the students/ parents.
- The college is not liable for any loss of valuables during the student's tenure at the Pak Red Crescent Medical & Dental College. Students are requested to safeguard their own belongings.

All students must wear an overall and college ID card during college working hours.



EXAMINATIONS

Examinations are of two kinds:

- I) Internal Examinations
- II) University Examinations

- I) Internal Examinations

Send Up examinations shall be compulsory for students of all classes. Students who do not appear or fail in the examination will be regarded as students whose courses of instructions are incomplete and unsatisfactory and will not be allowed to appear in the university professional examination for promotion to the next higher class and may also lose the scholarship, if any, granted to them. Pass percentage for Send up examinations is 50%.

A) MBBS

- i) First Year M.B.B.S. There will be send up examination in the subjects of Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry. Students will not be allowed to sit in the University Examination if they fail in any of the subjects in the send up examination.
- ii) Second Year M.B.B.S. There will be send up examination in the subjects of Anatomy, Physiology and Biochemistry. Failed Students will not be allowed to sit in the University Examination if they fail in any of the subjects in the send up examination.
- iii) Third Year M.B.B.S. There will be one send up examination. The subjects will be: -
 1. Pharmacology and Therapeutics
 2. Forensic Medicine and Toxicology
 3. General Pathology
 4. Behavioural Sciences
 5. Clinical Methods in Surgery
 6. Clinical Methods in Medicine



All subjects will be compulsory for the purpose of examination but only those students will be detained from appearing in the University Examination who fail in any of the **first four subjects**.

- i) **Fourth Year M.B.B.S.** There will be send up examination in the following subjects: -
1. Special Pathology
 2. Community Medicine
 3. Ophthalmology
 4. Otorhinolaryngology
 5. Medicine
 6. Surgery
 7. Obstetrics & Gynaecology

The students will be allowed to sit the University Examination only if they clear at least the first four subjects.

- ii) **Final Year M.B.B.S.** The send up examination will be conducted in the following subjects:
1. Medicine & Allied Specialties including Psychiatry and Dermatology
 2. Surgery & Allied Specialties including Orthopaedics and Anaesthesia,etc.
 3. Obstetrics & Gynaecology
 4. Paediatrics

The students will be allowed to appear in the University Examination only if they pass in all subjects.





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
